

STRUCTURAL CHANGE IN TRADE REGIME IN ASIA

- Conversing RTA/FTAs in 2000s : AFTAとASEAN +CJKAZ FTAs, Mega pacts (CPTPP, RCEP, Japan-US, Japan-EU)
- WTO in change, Prevailing pluri-pacts: Expanded ITA, EGA, EC
- Left behind: US in TPP, India in RCEP, CJK beyond RCEP (CPTPP??)
- Structural changes :
 - 1) Slow trade (2015 \sim) \rightarrow How to convince the role of GVC for voters
 - 2) Reshoring and GVC restructuring → Constraints in GVC participation through FDI for developing countries
 - 3) DX and lacking binding rules \rightarrow Data localization, Source code opening...
 - 4) US-China trade war → Middle powers?
 - 5) Economic security, Environment, Human rights agenda in trade → RTA (like minded group) if WTO does not function?


Frameworks of major Asia-Pacific trade deals

STRATEGIC AGENDA FOR CJK (1): BEYOND FTA FOR COMMON RULES

- Generous rule of origins for better regional value chains (RCEP)
- Implementation agenda: Trade facilitation, SPS regulations, Dispute settlement….
- Common Data rules? :
 - TPP-3: 1) Free data flow 2) Controlling data localization
 - 3) Prohibition of source code opening requirement
 - RCEP: Limited but similar in 1) 、2) but how to agree in 3)?
- Data rules based on the nature: Non-economic values, Public goods characteristics, Externalities, Domination by platformers
 - → Consumer protection, IPR protection, Competition policies
 - → Public health, Environment, Security → Privacy protection, Cyber security

STRATEGIC AGENDA FOR CJK (2): PROVIDING PUBLIC GOODS AND TRUST BUILDING PROJECTS

- ICT environment in late developing countries: Infrastructures, HR development, Administration services
- SDGs related projects: Environment business, Smart cities, Energies efficiencies, Public health
- Trust building projects: Basic science (Public health, Gerontology, Aging society), Service industries (Tourism again, Culture and sport business), Agriculture innovation and Food security issues, Natural disaster
 - Renovation in BITs for CJK BITs (Beyond China-EU), Service sector liberalization
