




Policies and institutions for coping with population aging


- Policies of countries that have experienced aging
 1)Expansion of the working-age population; immigration policy
 - 2) increase productivity; Industrial automation and the proliferation of robotics
 - 3) Increase labor participation rate: Expansion of use of female and elderly workforce
- Elderly welfare with a large gap between the system and reality
- Retirement of the baby boomer generation and entry into the elderly
- Discussion on expanding the working-age population is inevitable
- Reorganization of labor and capital markets to provide more opportunities for older people to work



Changes in the demographic structure of ROK




Population composition by age in ROK






Economic participation rate and change by gender

(단위: %, %p)




