## Asia-Japan JEF Forum in Taipei on Oct. 12 Stressed Catalyst Role of Taiwan in Trade Liberalization Efforts in Asia

JEF, in cooperation with the Taiwan Institute of Economic Research (TIER), organized its annual conference with leading Asian trade thinkers in Taipei in October, 2011. Many of the participating panelists were the distinguished authors of articles for Japan SPOTLIGHT including Dr. Mignonne Chan, one of our most frequent columnists, who is Executive Director of the Chinese APEC Study Center and our co-organizer.

This was the 10th conference since 2003 and the participants' passion and enthusiasm finally made it possible for us to gain an overall view of the ultimate Asian regional trade liberalization. As shown in the title of the conference, "Seeking a New Balance in the Regional Integration of the Asia-Pacific Region," we could see a new balance in Asia after evaluation of the development of the East Asia Free Trade Area (EAFTA), Comprehensive Economic Partnership in East Asia (CEPEA), China-Japan-Korea FTA, Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP) and Economic Cooperation Framework Agreement (ECFA), a variety of increasing FTAs in Asia This new balance should be seen from the perspective of supply chain connectivity and disaster resilience, a national security concern, as well as from the viewpoint of the economic policy concern. All the participants agreed that Asia should be at the center of global trade liberalization, performing as a resisting counterveiling power against a possible drastic increase in protectionism in Europe and the USA in the midst of the economic and budget crisis. In this regard, the role of Taiwan is very important, in particular after having been successful in switching its cross-strait relations with China from confrontation to cooperation by concluding the ECFA. Taiwan is surely capable of greatly contributing to cohesion within East Asia by implementing the ECFA. In the light of this, Taiwan should be invited to participate in the mechanism of regional integration of the Asia-Pacific region.
