(PHP Institute, Inc.; Monthly)

The English-language section contains serious articles and features that introduce the reader to various facets of Japan. (JAL Cultural Development Co.; Monthly)

It contains translations of items appearing in its sister newspaper, the vernacular <i>Asahi Shimbun</i>. (Asahi Daily News; Daily)

(Japan Economic Review, Ltd.; Monthly) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>The Daily Yomiuri</i>: One of Japan's four English-language daily newspapers with a nationwide readership. Most important political and economic stories and local items are translated from its sister publication, the <i>Yomiuri Shimbun</i>. (Yomiuri Shimbun; Daily)

(Diamond Lead Co.; Monthly) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>The Japan Economic Journal</i>: The international weekly edition of its daily Japanese-language counterpart, the <i>Nihon Keizai Shimbun</i>, containing articles and news of interest to businesspeople. (Nihon Keizai Shimbun; Weekly)

(Japan Times, Ltd.; Daily)

Associated with its sister newspaper, the vernacular <i>Mainichi Shimbun</i>. (Mainichi Newspapers; Daily)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>The Japan Foundation Newsletter</i>: Contains articles about Japanese culture and international exchange. (Japan Foundation; Bimonthly)
